2025 EHRC Calendar

We know people are keen to understand the 2025 EHRC calendar. The calendar is now decided, and there are some changes from 2024. The FIA World Motor Sport Council will officially approve the calendar on December 11th. However, we are trying to publish a draft of the calendar as soon as possible. We thank you for your patience. We confirm that Round 1 is **Rally Costa Brava** in March, followed by the **Vltava Historic Rallye** in the Czech Republic in April.

2025 EHRC Sporting Regulations

To confirm, **EHRC 2025** is open to cars in **Categories 1-4**. There will be opportunities for cars homologated between 1993 and 2000 to compete on our events too. For 2025 these cars will be included in **one single class** and **will not be eligible for points within EHRC**. Also, cars in Category 1-4 will always be together during the events on all days. Any other cars, including 93-00 cars, will follow them.

We confirm that Period J2 cars in Category 4 are eligible up to December 31st 1992 specification.
