RALLY SCHEDULE

Monday 2nd March: Rally HQ opens, administrative checks and all documents available

Wednesday 3rd 4th March: Optional Private Test, morning or afternoon. Technical Scrutineering for "OPEN"

Thursday 4th 5th March: Technical Scrutineering all day (individual schedule)

Leg 1 (only Sporting): Start Ceremony on the evening and SS1 in the night

Friday 5th 6th March: Leg 2 (start Regularity event) SS2-3-4 (x2)

Saturday 6th 7th March: Leg 3, SS5-6-7 (x2), and prize giving in the evening

ENTRIES

The rally is limited to **260** starting crews.

From **10th November** 2025 an official **Registration period** will open until a limit of 150 places is reached. The rest of teams will be assigned to a **WAITING LIST**. Payment date will determine the position on the Waiting List.

Another 110 places will be reserved for: FIA EHRC teams registered on 2026 season, CERVH classified teams on the 2025 season and FCA teams.

The remaining spots after FIA, CERVH and FCA entries closing date will be completed with teams from the Waiting List. The teams selected to enter the Rally will be announced from **17th February** 2026.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

Any competitor who wishes to enter the Rally Costa Brava must send fully filled the application form available at www.rallyclassics.org accompanied by proof of payment (by Bank Transfer or Card Payment) of the total amount of the entry fee to the Organiser's bank account. Any uncomplete application will not be validated.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fees are fixed at:

- **Sporting** (FIA EHRC / CERVH / OPEN Trophy / FCA): **1.495€**
- **Regularity**: **1.195€**

Discount of 200€ for: Female drivers (All categories)
Cars with engine capacity lower than 1800cc without Turbo (only Sporting)

GOLDEN PACK ENTRY (limited availability)

- Sporting: **2.495€**
Includes: Entry fee + private test + 7 hotel nights (double/twin room) from Sunday 01/03 + photo report.
- Regularity: **1.600€**
Includes: Entry fee + 4 hotel nights (double/twin room) from **Thursday 05/03** **Wednesday 04/03 until Sunday 08/03** + photo report.

REFUNDS POLICY

Entry fees will be refunded in full to candidates whose entry has not been accepted.

- The organizer shall refund 80% of the entry fee to competitors who are obliged to withdraw for reasons of force majeure if this happens before entries closing date (16th February 2026).
- If this happens from 17th February 2026 to 1st March 2026 a maximum of 50% shall be refunded.
- No refunds after 01/03/2026.

SERVICE PARK

Open from 08:00 on 4th March

Service Park space per entry: 36 m2.

Additional space on Service Park: 8 €/ m2 (adding more than 18m2 → includes an Auxiliary Service plate).

Auxiliary Service Plate: 100 € (Allows to enter on Service Park)

Hospitalities only for teams with minimum of 5 cars.

PRIVATE TEST

Optional private test will be organised only for registered Sporting crews.

Will take place on Wednesday 4th March 2026, morning and afternoon sessions

Only after passing administrative checks

Full security equipment will be required

Price: 275€ per car

Orders received before 23/02/2026 will be delivered directly to the Service Park.

On Leg 1, starts will be given according to the race numbers.

For the following Legs, the start will be given according to the classification of the previous Leg, always sorted by championship groups: FIA/CERVH/OPEN/Regional
